MONEY TALKS**Student A**

You've had an argument with your boy-/girlfriend about his/her extravagant use of money and want to make peace by apologizing to him/her. But you also want to make suggestions on what you should both do in the future to manage your finances better in the flat you share.

Student B

You're the boy-/girlfriend of Student A. (S)he wants to apologize to you for the argument (s)he started the previous evening about your use of money. (S)he also wants to talk to you about your joint financial situation and how it could be handled since you share a flat together. React to his/her apology and suggestions and give some of your own.

Cover at least the following topics:

- Student A: apologizing for the argument
- Student B: accepting the apology
- Student A: explaining why you started the argument in the first place
- Student B: defending your spending habits
- making suggestions and reacting to them
- reaching a conclusion
