## Ethnic and place names are often used as derisive adjectives

Most of these derisive adjectives reflect stereotypes about the ethnicity or the place. Most are pejorative and some are offensive.

The usage of ethnic or place-based adjectives can be sensitive and potentially offensive. It's important to use language respectfully and be aware of the connotations and historical context of such phrases.
